

COURSE ASSESMENT

The assessment report submitted on various courses taught in the first and third semesters of the academic year 2020-2021 was studied and analyzed. The majority of the students responded in a positive way to the assessment process. A major section of the students responded that the courses were relevant, and interesting. A minor section has the opinion that some courses are interesting but somewhat difficult. About one-third of the students had the opinion that the courses are having good coverage of the subject concerned and they are very stimulating. Most of the students are very much interested to continue their further studies in the same subject. As a whole, the students are satisfied with various qualitative and quantitative aspects of the courses. However, a very minute fraction of students feels the content of the courses is somewhat difficult to understand. For them, appropriate remedial classes have to be arranged in the future along with more examples, demonstrations, and field/experimental studies. Further, the portions cited should be positively considered in the next revision of the courses.

TEACHER ASSESMENT

The analysis of the reports on the assessment by students submitted by the teachers of the department shows that the students are satisfied with the various components of teacher assessment. The grades accorded by the students range from very good to good. In general, the assessment reports demands only slight improvement in components such as clarity of explanation/communication skill, stimulating discussion and original thinking among students, special care for weak students, and motivation. These shortcomings, though in very minute degrees, should be corrected in the next semester's classes.


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
