Smt. Ramyasree.P.R, Parkunnel, Thazhamunda, Thazhamunda.P.O, Wayanad, PIN 673596 who has been advised by the Kerala Public Service Commission, Thiruvananthapuram, vide the Advice letter read above, is provisionally appointed as Scientific Officer (Biology) in the scale of pay of Rs. 36600 - 79200 in the Forensic Science Laboratory, Police Department. She will report before the Director, Forensic Science Laboratory, Thiruvananthapuram within 15 days on receipt of this Appointment Order.

02. The above appointment is subject to the Rule 3(c) of the General Rules of the Kerala State and Subordinate Service Rules 1958. The appointment will be provisional subject to the provisions contained in Rule 3(c) and Rule 10(b) and Sub Rule 9(i) of the General Rules of the KS&SSR, 1958 and subject to verification of character and antecedents as contemplated in GO(P)No.49/74/PD Dated 05/03/1974. If anything adverse is noticed during verification of character and antecedents, her service will be terminated without further notice as per the provisions in GO(MS)191/74/Home Dated 29/11/1974. The appointment order will be cancelled, if it is found that there is suppression or misrepresentation of material facts on the part of the applicant at the time of forwarding the application or during the course of the enquiry conducted by the Department.

03. On appointment, she will be undergoing training in the State Forensic Science Laboratory for a minimum period of six months. On completion of the training she will be on probation for a total period of 2 years on duty within a continuous period of 3 years. She should pass the Account Test for Executive Officers (Kerala) during the period of probation, if she has not already passed the test.

04. She will execute a Bond to the effect that she will serve the State Government at least for a period of five years after training, failing which she will be liable to pay the State Government the required amount stipulated in the Order of the Government of Kerala regarding the persons who leave the service before the completion of five years.

05. She will also execute a Bond amount of Rs. 25,000/- in Kerala Stamp Paper worth Rs.200/- (Non Judicial Stamp Paper) along with two sureties preferably Gazetted Officers below the age of 50 and in the case of others, Solvency Certificate from the Tahsildar of the concerned Taluk will also be produced.

06. She will produce the following documents in Original before the Director, Forensic Service Laboratory, Thiruvananthapuram at the time of reporting for duty. (i) Medical
